The SJCRME (Scottish Joint Committee for RME) exists to support RME across Scotland. We are an organisation made up of representatives from religious and belief groups and teaching organisations from across the nation and we work together to ensure that RME remains a high quality experience for all learners. We also aim to provide support for individuals or groups to ensure that RME remains a relevant and important part of the whole school experience and curriculum.

We have recently developed our constitution and are looking for passionate and committed practicing teachers from all sectors who are keen to support RME to be involved in the work of SJCRME as a co-opted teacher member. As a co-opted member you would work as part of our curriculum and conferences groups to engage with the wider profession, identify issues and come up with creative ways of supporting staff across the country. The position of Co-opted Teacher Member of SJCRME shall be co-opted for no more than a period of three years at which point a re-application can be submitted for a further period of service.

The post is voluntary and will require attendance at 2/3 meetings per year. Meetings will be held centrally and it may also be possible for people to attend using technology thus making applications open to all from across Scotland.

Co-opted Teacher Members will serve on either/both Curriculum and Conferences Committees and will help to undertake the work of the committees. Travelling expenses will be paid for attendance at meetings.
